Once the new Congress is in place, it will oversee over \$1.2 billion annually for the next five years, impacting Jews who live in Israel and in the diaspora. There are 21 slates competing for seats, each with its own platform. If you want people who think like you to decide where money is allocated or which policies matter, you must choose the slate that best matches your values.
